- 5. Louisiana Association of Public Charter Schools (LAPCS)
- 6. Urban League of Louisiana
- 7. New Orleans Campaign for Grade-Level Reading
- 8. New Orleans Business Alliance
- 9. Greater New Orleans, Inc.
- 10. Charter School Leader (to be selected by LAPCS); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the working group shall present its recommendations to the School Board by no later than the October 2018 School Board business meeting; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the representative entities by no later than June 30, 2018.
